Gordon Brown is insisting that public sector workers must accept pay cuts in real terms in order to combat inflation - yet public sector workers are the victims of inflation, not the cause.

Postal workers are in a national dispute over pay, conditions, jobs and working practices. Hundreds of thousands of civil servants are set to take action over pay, job cuts, privatisation and conditions. Almost a million local government workers are balloting for strike action over pay. Teachers are facing four years of pay restraint and considering balloting for action.
