- A further £70 million cuts announced last month
- Disastrous spending cuts in mental health services
- Hammersmith Hospital: 300 jobs going
- The Royal Free Hospital, Hampstead: 480 jobs going
- St Georges Hospital, Tooting: 300 jobs lost last year, a further 150 to go
- Queen Elizabeth Hospital Woolwich bankrupt as a result of PFI
- Service cuts and redundancies across London
- Moves to privatise GP services and diagnostic tests
